

# ***"O Christmas Tree"***

**A German Folk Tune, the modern lyrics were written in 1824, by the Leipzig organist, teacher and composer Ernst Anschütz and framed from a 16th-century Silesian folk song by Melchior Franck, "Ach Tannenbaum."**

***Arranged for Solo Plectrum Guitar by Brian Johns***

This arrangement is easy on the fingers and played in the open position or key of "C." We're using familiar chord forms like "C," "Dm" and a smaller "G7." The greatest challenge will be found in bringing out the melody.

I've included fingering suggestions in the tablature stave with fingering for the melody above and fingering for the harmony below the staff. As per usual, all harmony is colored red.
